C2C Program Administration

Greetings National Board of the National Association of Blacks in Criminal Justice. The following is an outline of how we envision the C2C program to be carried out:

-For starters let us revisit the overall goals of this program

- Coordinate a stronger relationship between local and student chapters
- Foster a smooth transition from student to adult membership
- Establish a formal process for joining a chapter in the region of choice
- Restore high retention and membership rates for chapters around the country
- Network = Net Worth

Program Requirements:

- Prior membership in a student chapter
- Attendance to at LEAST three (3) meetings and one (1) community service project/chapter event UNLESS otherwise approved by Chapter President
- Successful submission of ALL documentation to receive one-year membership waiver
- All communications filtered through nabcjcollege2career@gmail.com & nabcjstudents@gmail.com

Implementation:

- Participants in the C2C Program must present their graduation date to the committee (unofficial transcript or other documentation) along with: region(s) of choice, resume/CV, and field of preference to the C2C Committee and National President
- Graduating seniors must present their graduation date to the committee at LEAST six (6) months prior to allow for committee assistance in chapter assignment
- With proper submission the student will have one year (365 days) from the date of their graduation to join a local adult chapter of their choice
- Once student joins they must contact C2C Committee to properly receive one-year waiver; if student joins on the 366th day (one year and one day) after graduation they will be required to pay full price for membership. Membership attained outside of this program will also require payment of the full membership price
- C2C Database will be used to revitalize the NABCJ Annual Job/Career Fair for graduating seniors

Duties:

- Chairs: implement proper procedures and protocol for C2C program as approved by the National Board. Verify student graduation dates & successful waiver of membership fee
- Membership Directors: maintain contact with C2C participants during transitional phase to ensure smooth adjustment process
- Committee: assist chairs/directors in implementation of C2C program; assist in chapter selection; coordinate annual job/chapter fair

Optional: Recognize C2C participants once they successfully join a chapter @ the student reception (small certificate)
